









Key Programs: Anganwadi to Employment







Anganwadi Program





Our holistic Anganwadi interventions are designed to foster a nurturing environment for the well-being of the children, along with a safe space to engage with parents and caregivers. Our objective is to transform Anganwadis from 'Day care centres' to 'Centres of Learning'. We currently operate in 8 anganwadis, with 197 children.

Focus Areas

- Enhancing the quality of the learning environment
- Community Engagement (webinars and workshops with parents, caregivers, teachers, etc.)
- Advocacy and Sustainability (work with the Department of Women and Child Development to build capacity within the structure)
- Learning at home through a Multi-Modal system
- Online learning
- School readiness activities

Teacher Salaries



As per guidance received from the Department of Education, Karnataka, each school has an SDMC, a committee of parents who hold a joint account with the headmaster. All contributions for salaries can be made to this account through an approved NGO of your choice.

Learning Resources





Beneficiaries: 6000 students in 15 Government Schools in Bangalore

At the beginning of each academic year, every student receives learning resources that include a school bag, a pair of school shoes, 2 sets of uniforms, a sweater, a belt, a pair of socks, notebooks and stationary/a geometry box.

Education Interventions: Math





Challenges

- Serious deficiency in fundamental numeracy
- A lack of individual attention from teaching staff, combined with a lack of resources
- Conventional teaching is syllabus focused and pays scant attention to learning outcomes and understanding of concepts

Our Program

- Each school is provided with teachers and lesson plans
- The syllabus is aligned to the government school curriculum
- A hybrid-model of online video lessons and in-person sessions
- Baseline assessments and differentiated learning
- Learning assessments for each student after completion of a concept/topic

Education Interventions: English





Challenges

- Lack of qualified English teachers
- Students in the higher grades are unable to read, speak or write English at their grade-level.
- Conventional teaching methods with no attention to learning outcomes

Our Programs

- A qualified facilitator is assigned to each school
- A hybrid-model of online video lessons and in-person sessions
- Baseline assessment and differentiated learning
- LSRW approach (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing) with emphasis on phonetics, blends and digraphs
- Integrating English into school activities

Education Interventions: Life Skills





Challenges

- Over 50% of school-going children have behavioral and emotional problems
- Low attendance rates
- Students experience high levels of worry and stress major causes are financial issues, family problems, abuse faced at home and outside, amongst others

Our Programs

- WHO-recommended core life skills, including problem solving, creative thinking, interpersonal skills, empathy and coping with stress
- Age-specific topics for each class
- Counselling for students
- Talent development programs

Art & Crafts





Challenges

- Government school children need to regularly experience a sense of achievement and pride, to boost self-confidence
- Lack of comprehensive art programs in government schools
- It is essential to foster creativity and nurture imagination

Our Programs

- Age-appropriate art programs designed for grades 1-4
- Activities are designed to be undemanding, using easy-to-find materials
- The program integrates spoken English practice
- The modules stimulate creativity and motor skill development

Online Learning Support: SPUTNIK






SPUTNIK is an **online learning and digital engagement** platform. Students are assigned learning levels and are divided amongst WhatsApp groups headed by a facilitator, who then shares level-appropriate **activities that incorporate Math**, **Life Skills and English**.


Progress is tracked via a dashboard on the platform. Students receive 3 activities a week (in the form of videos and MCQs) in Maths, English, Sports and Life Skills.

Alumni Support & Scholarships





Keeping in line with the Government's National Education Policy 2020, our programs aim to increase the gross enrolment ratio in higher education, including vocational education, from 26.3% (2018) to 50% by 2035.

Scholarships are offered to students, to be utilised for expenses encompassing tuition fees, stipends, transport expenses, and any consumables (as required). 106 students benefit from scholarships in FY21-22.

As part of the COLA program, regular meetings are conducted to educate and counsel students on different options for future careers.

Career Counselling





To create a strong network with the means of connecting students to opportunities after they pass out from school, Colours of Life founded an alumni program in 2017 called the Colours of Life Academy (COLA).

COLA ensures students stay in touch after graduating from the primary or secondary schools. COLA activities and programs focus on three key pillars – academic support, skill development, mentoring and career counselling.

We currently have a total of 852 students in our COLA database, with 364 actively in-contact or availing programs.

Skill Development & Employability





Facility Management Skilling program — A training program for Government School alumni, aimed at enhancing employment opportunities and arming them with the skills and knowledge to join the workforce. Upon completion of the course, the upskilled students are awarded well-paying jobs. 26 alumni graduated our inaugural course this year.

Timeline: 4 months

Cost per person: Rs. 15,000

Threads of Life – A vocational tailoring program available to government school alumni and their families at a skill development centre set up in Tarahunise village, North Bangalore

Timeline: 6 months

Cost per person: Rs. 15,000





Sinchana: Children's Day





Every Children's Day, Colours of Life hosts an interschool competition called **Sinchana**. This is a celebration during which government school students come together and showcase their talents.

It is a day filled with song, debate, face painting, mehendi art, dance, mime, and a plethora of other talents.
