Lack of safe & sanitary infrastructure, including clean classrooms, toilets and drinking water



Low attendance and poor academic performance due to easily preventable health issues

## Preventive Awareness: Comprehensive Health Screening





**Objective:** Conduct annual health check-ups for government school children

Screening of: Dental, vision, skin, anemia, ENT

- Scope:
- Individual health reports for each child that feed into a records database
- Sponsored medical treatments
- Case grants for long term treatments











## Preventive Awareness: Health Kits





#### **FULL KIT**

- 2 Face Masks
- 24 Shampoo Sachets
- 3 Bars of Soap
- 1 Toothbrush
- 3 Tubes of Toothpaste
- 6 Packets of Sanitary Napkins

Cost per kit: Rs. 435 (inclusive of delivery, branding, sanitary napkins)

#### Frequency:

Thrice a year (July, October and February)

## Process for Distribution of Health Kits





1

#### **Pre-Distribution:**

- Confirm date with the school headmaster or headmistress (HM)
- Place order with vendor.
- Calls are made to each parent using the phone number database

2

#### Distribution:

- Temperature is checked for every beneficiary and hand sanitizer is provided.
  - Beneficiary is cross checked against a student database.
- Table is setup with each item, and one team member provides an overview of kit content.

3

#### **Post-Distribution:**

- Signed acknowledgement letter is received from each HM
- The student database is updated with any new contacts and marked for those who received the health kits
- Reports are provided to all stakeholders, along with pictures













## **Nutritional Snacks**





Objective: Provide additional nutritional supplements to government school children on a weekly basis

**Product:** Paper Boat Chikki Bars

Role: Liase with vendor and school administration to notify them about the program and schedule. This includes identifying a person of contact in the school, who will receive the stock, sign delivery receipts, and ensure that orders are made according to the strength of the students. Excess bars will be used for the next round of distribution.

#### Frequency:

- If schools are open, 3 chikki bars per child, per week for 10 months
- If schools close due to Covid-19, chikki bars can be distributed every
  - 2-3 months along with the health kits

Implementing partner: BNRT 25

Cost per bar: Rs. 6




## Preventive Awareness: Awareness Collaterals



## **Daily School Maintenance**





#### Scope:

- Professional team of janitors and supervisors deployed
- Daily cleaning of:
  - Classrooms, Toilets and Common Area
  - Drinking water safety assessment
  - Cleaning overhead tanks and water sumps twice in a year









Implementing partner: BNRT 25

Approx. cost for a medium-size school: Rs. 60,000 including cleaning, consumables and cleaning staff salaries

## Clean Drinking Water & Handwash Stations





#### Measures include:

- RO drinking water facilities
- Handwashing facilities with provision of soap
- Conducting periodic maintenance checks to validate that facilities are working as expected

Implementing partner: BNRT 25

Cost per RO unit for 300 students: Rs. 70,000
