A lack of basic school infrastructure including clean toilets, electricity and safe drinking water



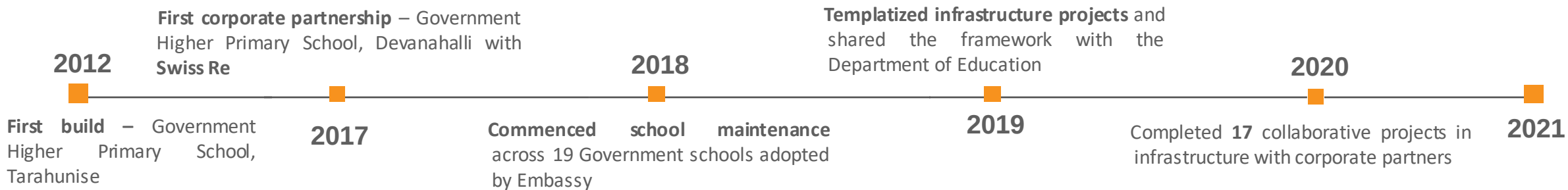
Overcrowded and dilapidated classrooms with insufficient furniture and proper lighting

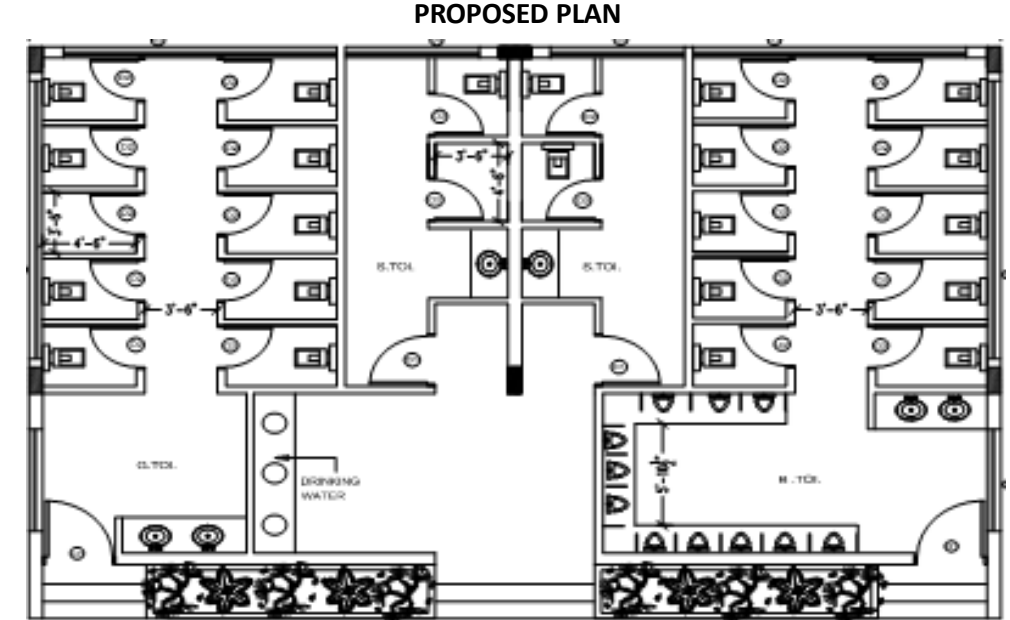

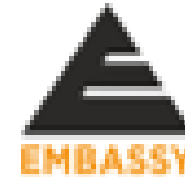

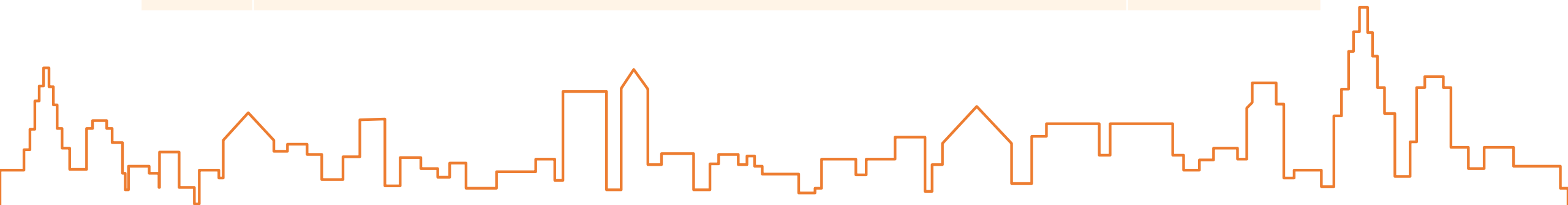

Estimated Costs for Infrastructure Opportunities

Opportunities	Estimated Cost
New school building for around 500 students	3.5cr (15 classrooms, furniture & fitouts, toilets, play area, solar, rainwater harvesting)
Building 1 new Classroom with furniture	15L per classroom
Toilet block of 20 toilets for students, and 4 toilets for staff	45L per block
Repairs & renovations (terrace waterproofing, painting, flooring, doors & windows, etc.)	38L
Solar panel installation	5.5L per school
Rainwater water system	6L per school
Clean drinking water (1 RO Unit suitable for 500 children)	50K per unit
Handwash station – stainless steel	80K per station (includes unit + civil)
Classroom furniture	1.2L per classroom
